

# Educational Museums with Free Virtual Tours

**1. NASA** - Take a virtual tour of NASA's [International Space Station](#)! There's a series of cool YouTube videos that take you through their station.

**2. Google Museum View** - Google Maps has cool street maps, allowing you to see virtually any place in a 360 degree view as if you were already there. [Google Museums](#) offers the same thing with museums! You can see panoramic views of beautiful places around the world. There are museums from all over the world; the United States, France, Spain, Indonesia, South Africa, and more!

**3. Smithsonian Museum** - Move over *Night at the Museum* and try the [Smithsonian Museum](#) virtual tour! The format is a bit like Google Maps, and you can "move" around and get a 360 degree view.

**6. Lincoln Memorial** - National Park Services has panoramas of the [Lincoln Memorial](#). Click and drag to experience things up-close, so you can read inscriptions. They also have a map of the whole memorial, which makes it easy to quickly move from location to location.

**7. Yad Vashem** - Yad VaShem is Israel's official Holocaust memorial. Their [YouTube page](#) has several tours of memorials, including their garden honoring the Righteous Among the Nations.

**8. Martin Luther King Jr.'s Home** - Take a virtual tour of [Martin Luther King Jr's home](#). King was a great leader and helped shape the Civil Rights movement. Click on each room in his house, and a video will play.
