PINE KNOLLS CEMETERY LOT SALES

Each Grave is 4 feet wide x 12 feet long. At this time vaults are required for all full burials. No vault is required for cremation burials and we have no requirements for the type of urn used.

Cost per grave

Hanover residents is \$650 and

Non-residents is \$2050

Burial Fees

Full Burial is \$650

Cremation Burial is \$250

Interments per grave

1 full and 1 cremated interment

or

4 cremated internments

Monuments & Markers

1. Single grave
 - a. horizontal flat grass markers only, one foot by 2 feet;
2. Two grave lot
 - a. 3 to 4 feet long and not over 16 inches wide, height of die thirty-five to forty inches;
3. Three grave lot
 - a. 4 to 5 feet long and not over 16 inches wide, height of die not over forty-eight inches;
4. Six grave lot
 - a. Maximum of to 7 1/2 feet long and not over 16 inches wide; height of die not over 48 inches unless otherwise approved by Board of Selectmen.
5. Flat markers
 - a. 2 feet by 1 foot, may be used in connection with the family stone.
6. Flags and staffs for marking graves of Veterans of Military Service will be issued and placed by the Grounds Superintendent. Other flags and staffs are not permitted and will be removed.

When looking at the map of Block 10 at Pine Knolls Cemetery the areas in white are grave sites that are currently available. Each full rectangle is broken down into 6 individual grave sites (you can see this broken out on some of them).

Once we have confirmed a grave site(s) and received payment, we can begin the paperwork. About two weeks after you will receive the deed paperwork from the Town Clerks Office.
