## FORD SAYRE and KAST



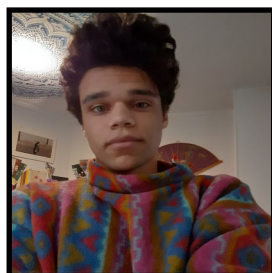
